David began his career with the IRS as a Revenue Agent in Daytona Beach in July 1984. In October 1984, David transferred to the Criminal Investigation Division in Orlando and has worked as a Special Agent in the Orlando area and Daytona Beach. David was promoted to a Supervisory Special Agent in October 2008.

David has conducted income tax investigations involving evasion of assessment, evasion of payment, failure to file, false returns and statements, aiding and abetting the preparation of false tax returns, false claims, and interference with the administration of the IRS. David has also conducted several conspiracy investigations involving both tax and non-tax criminal violations including mail and wire fraud, bank fraud, securities fraud, health care fraud, and structuring.

David was trained as a Cover Agent and for many years supported numerous undercover operations in Orlando, Miami, Sarasota, New York, Atlanta, Dallas, Las Vegas, and Seattle. He also worked on dignitary protection assignments in Central Florida during several presidential election campaigns and the 2002 Winter Olympics in Park City, Utah.

For the past eighteen months, David has supervised one of the two Criminal Investigation groups in Maitland as well as the St. Cloud-Internal Revenue Service-United States Secret Service (SCIRS-SS) Task Force. The SCIRS-SS Task force is comprised of Criminal Investigation and Secret Service Special Agents and officers from eight local law enforcement agencies including the Orlando, Maitland, Winter Park, St. Cloud, Kissimmee, and Palm Bay Police Departments and the Brevard and Osceola County Sheriffs' Offices. The SCIRS-SS Task Force primarily conducts white collar money laundering investigations and has seized in excess of \$200 million of criminally derived proceeds in the past two years.
